Spray applications continue to keep the turf healthy with the shorter growing days. Micronutrient applications will ensure that the turf will stay healthy through the cold months and ready for the spring. Irrigation on the golf course has been dialed back to a few times per week. Watering is rarely scheduled in the evenings if conditions for heavy frost or ice is expected. This is in an attempt to limit delaying morning tee times. Only if absolutely necessary will water be scheduled when freezing conditions are forecast. All morning setup will also be modified. When the turf slows in growth or I should say if, then clean up projects, tree trimming and landscaping will take center stage.

Thank you to all that participated in the holiday fund I can not express enough how wonderful and thoughtful it is for the staff to receive such a generous gift. I hope you all enjoyed your Thanksgiving Day and wish health and safety through the holiday season.
